**Informal Dinner Meeting**  
**Saturday, 28 January 1989**

2. A general discussion followed concerning the LGSU. some points made included:

Sec'y Castillo pointed out that the income from the dances projected for this year was \$1900. He stated that we needed to make sure that we neither cancelled future dances nor had any that were failures.

Sec'y Castillo pointed out that \$200 of our self generated income was supposed to be set aside to by refreshments but that it had been decided to let members supply the refreshments themselves. There had been no refreshments at the last two meetings.

The idea of having people volunteer to take certain areas of Grounds to hang posters was discussed and we decided to try this again. V.P. McWilliams will take the volunteers names at the next meeting.

The idea of publicizing meetings was worked out as follows. V.P. McWilliams would create a master meeting poster upon which V.P. Ensor could write each meeting's topic and speaker. V.P. Ensor would then take care of copying the posters and having them at the meetings for distribution.
